## **ST PETER'S ARE DELIGHTED TO ANNOUNCE THEIR A LEVEL RESULTS FOR 2022.**

We are all so proud of our 2022 cohort who have experienced three challenging academic years. In Year 11, they were denied the opportunity to sit their GCSEs due to Covid; at the beginning of 2021, they had to learn remotely for 10 weeks; and their time in St Peter's Sixth Form has been punctuated with various bouts of self-isolations of varying lengths. Our pupils have shown amazing resilience and maturity in overcoming these difficulties which have been put before them.

These are our headlines:

- 42% of the exam grades across all 'A' level and BTEC subjects were at A\*-A.
- The percentage number of grades achieved at A\*-B this year is over 72%, 10% above the national figure.
- A record 92% of the grades achieved were at A\*-C, again 10% above national figures.

These grades are exceptional for a fully inclusive school Sixth Form, but they do not tell the 'story' of the success of all of our individual students. They have virtually all been successful in securing their next steps, be that at university, employment or an apprenticeship. Nearly 80% of our students who applied for University have received offers from their first choice institution. Of these offers nearly half of them are from Russell Group Universities.

We offer huge congratulations to the class of 2022. We thank parents and families for all their support. Thank you also to their dedicated teachers for their expertise and efforts.

I would like to add my congratulations to the pupils and staff at St Peter's and encourage parents to consider this wonderful school when choosing secondary education for their children. Fr Rob
