NEWS AND EVENTS FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM:

Celebrating St Chad: Join us for a day of celebration and history organised collaboratively by St Chad's Cathedral and the Archdiocese of Birmingham History and Archives Commission. Saturday 18th June, opening with Mass at midday, including the Rite of the Dedication of the Altar. The historical event, for which booking is required, will begin after Mass with light refreshments, and an opportunity to visit a special historical exhibition in the Archives. Speakers include Dr John Jenkins from the University of York and Dr Judith Champ, Archdiocese of Birmingham.

Corpus Christi Procession, Birmingham: All welcome to join this year's procession on Sun 19th June. On the Feast of Corpus Christi, Mass at 1pm at St Michael's on Moor Street. The procession leaves at 2pm arriving at St Chad's at 2.30pm/2.45pm where there will be a small service with Benediction.

Annual Novena preparing for the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Friday 24 June 2022. Mass and Novena Prayers in Maryvale Chapel each evening at 7pm. From Thursday 16 to Friday 24 June. LEARNING WITHOUT BORDERS, BUDAPEST SUMMER CAMP FOR UKRAINIAN CHILDREN: Many of you will know that our community has been funding the extraordinary 'Learning Without Borders' school in Budapest. This is 15 Ukrainian teachers, teaching 80 refugee Ukrainian children, providing proper meals and nourishment for the children and enabling Ukrainian mothers to take part-time day jobs whilst their children learn.
