FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: We are delighted that Noah and Ethan are making their First Holy Communion this weekend. Please remember them in your prayers.

WE WELCOME ANDY EWING who was received into the Catholic Church and Confirmed this weekend. (Covid restrictions have prompted this for Saturday morning rather than at the Easter Vigil.)

HOLY WEEK AND EASTER SERVICES: Once again, because of the ongoing restrictions due to the Coronavirus pandemic, we have to ask you to book your places for church services. This will be for Palm Sunday, Holy Week and Easter Sunday Services. The booking system will be available from Monday on the parish website. The hall will be open for those who have not booked in - maximum of 30 people.

As usual, Holy Communion will be available for thirty minutes after each Mass or Service for those who have been following the above Holy Week Liturgies via the live stream.

NEW OFFERTORY ENVELOPES: - New boxes of offertory envelopes are now available for the financial year commencing 6th April 2021. Due to ongoing restricted Mass attendance, a limited number of boxes will be available in the narthex from this weekend. These should cater for those parishioners who have made a donation during the last 12 months using an envelope from their box (as opposed to bank transfer). Further boxes will be put out as restrictions on Mass numbers ease.

Note that smaller boxes containing just envelopes for the second collection are available for parishioners whose offertory donation is by standing order.
