SACRAMENTS: We are delighted that Ciaran is making his First Holy Communion this weekend. Please remember him in your prayers.

READERS are asked to read at the microphone on the sanctuary steps either from your own missal or from a Parish Mass Book.

ALL MASSES are open to the public. Please bring with you name and contact details on a slip of paper for track and trace, to be left in the basket as you enter the church. Face masks are to be worn, maintain 1m plus social distancing and please sanitise your bench and kneeler after use.

Please note our Bishops have not yet reinstated Sunday Mass obligation. Those whose health is vulnerable are welcome to continue with live stream.

PUBLIC MASSES. To maintain social distancing of 1m plus, the maximum number of household groups we can accommodate is fifty-two, these will be on a first come first served basis, with a further thirty in the parish centre with live streaming.

HOLY COMMUNION: Until the end of June, Holy Communion will be available for thirty minutes after each weekend Mass for those following via live stream.

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT will take place on Wednesday before the morning Mass - between 9am and 10am.
