LEARNING WITHOUT BORDERS, BUDAPEST SUMMER CAMP FOR UKRAINIAN CHILDREN: Many of you will know that our community has been funding the extraordinary 'Learning Without Borders' school in Budapest. This is 15 Ukrainian teachers, teaching 80 refugee Ukrainian children, providing proper meals and nourishment for the children and enabling Ukrainian mothers to take part-time day jobs whilst their children learn.
