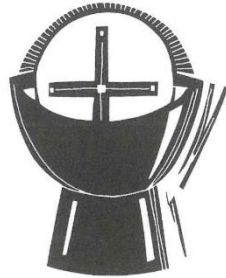

DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET is prayed each Friday following the morning Mass.


