SS PETER AND PAUL: Tuesday is the Solemnity of Ss Peter and Paul. The morning Mass will take place in the school so will not be live streamed. There will be an evening Mass in the Church at 7.30pm.

READERS are asked to read at the microphone on the sanctuary steps either from your own missal or from a Parish Mass Book.

FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR DAVID WATERS: Due to Covid restrictions, the number of mourners allowed in the Church are limited. Therefore, the Requiem Mass on Thursday morning will be for family only. Parishioners are welcome to attend David's Reception into Church on Wednesday evening at 5.30pm.

DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET is prayed each Friday following the morning Mass.

ALL MASSES are open to the public. Please bring with you name and contact details on a slip of paper for track and trace, to be left in the basket as you enter the church. Face masks are to be worn, maintain 1m plus social distancing and please sanitise your bench and kneeler after use.

Please note our Bishops have not yet reinstated Sunday Mass obligation. Those whose health is vulnerable are welcome to continue with live stream.

PUBLIC MASSES. To maintain social distancing of 1m plus, the maximum number of household groups we can accommodate is fifty-two, these will be on a first come first served basis, with a further thirty in the parish centre with live streaming.

HOLY COMMUNION: This is the last weekend Holy Communion will be available for thirty minutes after each Mass for those following via live stream.

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT will take place on Wednesday before the morning Mass - between 9am and 10am.
