ARRANGEMENTS FOR CHRISTMAS MASSES: The current 2m social distancing rule provides only 34 places in our Church, therefore a booking system is in operation. You can book your place/s online on the New Parish Website, please make sure you enter an email address to allow tickets and confirmation to be sent to you. If you want more than a pair of tickets we ask you to book by email or by text/phone on our dedicated booking line 07522 573657.

THE CHURCH IS OPEN FOR PUBLIC SERVICES: Please note our Bishops have not yet reinstated Sunday Mass obligation. Those whose health is vulnerable are welcome to continue with live stream or to come to midweek Masses when numbers will be lower.

PUBLIC MASSES. To maintain social distancing of 2m, the maximum number of household groups we can accommodate is thirty-four, these will be on a first come first served basis, with a further thirty in the parish centre with live streaming.

- The Government encourages us to adhere with Track and Trace guidance, people are invited to bring a piece of paper with their name and phone number or email address on, these can be dropped into the basket on entering the Church. They will be kept securely for three weeks before being destroyed. If you have the NHS App on your phone, please scan the QR Code.
- Please remember to wash your hands before setting off for Church and sanitise when you arrive in the Narthex.
- In accordance with Government advice, please wear a mask.
- Please maintain 2 metre social distancing and follow the instructions of the stewards.
- Please ensure you leave the Church via the Parish Centre.
