Dear Parishioners,

Every marathon or long-distance runner has to learn to pace themselves during a race, or they will run out of energy too soon and have to give up. As we begin the first week of Lent today, we need to find our pace and stick with it over the coming weeks. In a marathon we see the runners picking up a bottle of water to refresh themselves. We can refresh ourselves through a time of quiet prayer. I invite you to make a special effort to come and pray before the Blessed Sacrament on Sunday afternoon in the church starting at 4pm. You might not be able to come as early as 4pm so try 4.30pm and bring a cushion if you need one. At 5pm Stations of the Cross will begin and lasts about half an hour. It is a good time to go to Confession. I am sure we have all wished we could find the time to pray. Our church is a good place because it is devoid of distractions especially when you cannot see the door so do sit close to the altar if possible. You might read the Walk with Me Booklet, you might bring a Bible and read and reflect on some Scripture. Don't read too much, don't speak too much, give the Lord a chance to speak allow Him to get a word in edgeways. Each week of Lent we shall have Exposition at the same time of 4pm on Sunday afternoon, with Stations of the Cross at 5pm.
