Happy Feast Day! On the Cross Our Lord Jesus Christ offered himself as the sacrifice that takes away the sins of the world. This one single sacrifice of Christ is made present for us in the sacrifice of the Mass. When the priest pronounces the words of Christ "this is my body, this is my blood" the bread and wine are transformed into the body and blood of Christ himself.
