ST. GEORGE & ST. TERESA CATHOLIC CHURCH DORRIDGE

17th March 2024 5th Sunday of Lent Year B

Dear Parishioners,

Holy Week is fast approaching. The schools break up for Easter on Friday. Palm Sunday is next Sunday. This week our Gift Aid helpers will speak briefly at the end of Mass about the distribution of envelopes for planned giving and the Gift Aid situation. With this in mind, I thought it might be useful to share some parish figures to help you to understand the gravity of their talk.

Our annual income in 2023 was £108,815 (2022 £93,724) and our annual expenditure for 2023 was £114,348 (2022 £177,095) NB the cost of church roof repairs in 2022 was c.£94,600). The annual income includes the Gift Aid return £13,255 (2022 £12,931). The offertory or first collection in 2023 was £66,639 (2022 £58,054). The shortfall was near £48,000. The difference between our first offertory collection and our total income was made up by the Gift Aid return, Parish Centre profit of £1,664, 200 Club, sundry income, donations and one small legacy of £3,744.

The Diocesan Levy in 2023 was £16,140 (2022 £21,314). In 2023 our average Sunday church attendance was 196. The parish payment of the Diocesan Levy is our contribution for the Clergy and Clerical, Curia (Safeguarding, Marriage Offices, HR, Communications, Legal and Compliance, the Archbishop's office, as well as the support staff and services provided by the Diocese), Birmingham Diocesan Education Service, Clergy Training, Maryvale Institute, Chaplaincies and charitable grants. A full breakdown of the expenditure can be found on the Diocese website.

In 2023 the new Church Maintenance Fund gave us just £1239 and is used to pay for essential repairs and replacements. It is not levied by the diocese and is a special fund. We can gain gift aid from our donations to it. The main weekly first offertory pays for everything else. The new church boilers cost £10k. I shall distribute special church maintenance fund envelopes and I need to ask you to be generous.

As you can see, the income from the Sunday Offertory alone is not sufficient to keep the parish afloat and I am grateful for the extra sources of income from the Parish Centre but this year our income has not kept up with inflation and the cost of living.

I need to ask you to give more money to support the church.
