Dear Parishioners.

By the time most of us are reading this text, the Coronation of our new King Charles III will have taken place. I hope the ceremonies and occasion passed without any difficulties. The weather forecast for the early part of the Bank Holiday may be changeable. If I was standing on parade I would prefer a grey day than the heat of the sun!

Last week the Quinquennial Inspection of the Church, Parish Centre and Presbytery took place. The Architect and his assistant spent their time searching out those places where buildings are liable to show signs of wear and tear. As the name implies this is an Inspection of the Property which takes place every 5 years. The report will show what work needs to take place to keep the building in good order, with photographic evidence of those areas which need to be repaired or monitored. A copy is sent to the Diocese and we have one. The report will highlight the urgency of repairs via an A to D grading system. Category A repairs are the most urgent. I am happy to print a report for parishioners to peruse. This is not a document to put on the website but should any parishioner wish to see it I shall be happy to lend a copy.

One of the Category A recommendations from the 2017 Quinquennial Inspection (QI) was the repair of the roof.

Saturday is the optional Feast of Our Lady of Fatima. We still have a number of the DVD's "The Thirteenth Day" which I need to find a home. If you still have a DVD player and don't have a copy of this film they are free.
