Dear Parishioners.

Very many thanks for your contribution of warm clothes; coats, hats, gloves, scarves and socks to the appeal made by the SVP on behalf of the Druid's Heath SVP for the people of that area. The items were delivered last week and gratefully received.

This weekend there is a second collection for LEPRA which cares for people who suffer from the terrible disease of leprosy. In the time of Jesus this disease caused those who suffered from leprosy to be ostracised to live in colonies outside the towns. Nowadays there is treatment and medical interventions available to help those who suffer from it. There is a poster in the narthex and a website address for further information www.lepra.org.uk.

Over the last few weeks there have been various groundworks carried out to clear or reduce the height of trees and shrubs around the church site. In the process the wooden fence at the back of the carpark has been identified as being rotten and not fit for purpose and will be replaced at a cost of around £1,500. Something to add to our now monthly church maintenance collection which will be next weekend.

I have purchased some special Mass books for children after they return from their special service in the hall on Sunday Mornings. It will help our children to follow the Mass on their own and watch what is happening. Please help your child to concentrate on what is happening during the Mass by talking to them about it at home, showing them around the church, lighting a candle and making each Sunday a special day to look forward to. There are special prayers to say before Mass (in the books – My Simple Mass Book), also before and after Holy Communion. The Mass is the sacrifice of Christ for us to share together as a family.

A little early, I know, but you will see a display of goods for St Patrick's Day. However please take a look at the quality items available. Payment via the wall box under the window.

Would anyone be able to gift to the parish an upright vacuum cleaner in good working order? With a carpeted floor in church one of our vacuum cleaners has passed. We need another one and perhaps you can help?

Please remember in your prayers the children who will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> February at the 10.30am Mass. We shall welcome our area Bishop, David Evans to confer the Holy Spirit on and into the lives of the 30 children

attending this Mass with their families. As a parish community we pray with them for the Holy Sprit to strengthen and affirm their Christian faith, to help them to be active members of the Church and our family of believers here in Dorridge, Knowle, Bentley Heath and Hockley Heath.
