Dear Parishioners,

The 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod in Rome dedicated their prayers on Thursday morning to the Lord for peace in our world. The prayers were led by Iraqi Cardinal Louis Raphael Sako, Patriarch of the Chaldean Church, who prayed for all those suffering from war across the world and living in fear.

"Oh God, who cares for all, let the whole of humanity who have one origin from you, form one family, without violence, without absurd wars and with brotherly spirit, live united in peace and concord for Our Lord Jesus Christ Your Son, who is God, lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, for ever and ever. Amen."

Each weekday our Rosary Prayers Group prays before Mass for peace in our world. It is on live stream – you can hear via the audio link or, better still, come and pray for peace.

I am pleased to report that the old heating units have been removed and the new ones are in the process of being installed. I hope it will be ready for the cold snap which is being forecast by the meteorologists.
